The "middle-term" meetings were an integral part of the Youth 20 (Y20) 2024 methodology, conducted between the Pre-Summit, held from June 17 to 19 in Belém, Pará, and the Summit, scheduled from August 10 to 17 in Rio de Janeiro. These meetings were conducted virtually throughout July via Google Meet and Zoom.

The accomplished objectives included continuing and deepening the debates initiated at the Pre-Summit, drafting the final texts containing proposals for the August Summit, and facilitating the political and decision-making process. These steps were crucial to ensuring the effectiveness and cohesion of the deliberations. The actions aimed not only at consolidating the presented ideas and suggestions but also at building a consensus that reflected the diversity of participants' perspectives and interests, thus promoting constructive and inclusive dialogue.
